

Designed for comfort and sustainability, the house features a Genevex air system that regulates temperature and ensures a warm, dry environment year-round. Solar tubes on the roof and electric heat pumps efficiently heat the water. The main living space includes a Rais wood-burning stove for cosy nights in, a kitchen island with a Calor gas hob, an electric oven, and a built-in American-style fridge/freezer and dishwasher. The top floor opens onto a balcony with sweeping sea views.





Separate from the main house, The Bothy offers a private space for work or relaxation with its own stunning sea views. This home can function as a spacious single-family residence, two independent units, or a live-work-income combination where you reside in the main house, rent out The Studio, and use The Bothy as a workspace.






### FLOOR PLAN, DIMENSIONS & MAP
