The property is presented in excellent condition and benefits from gas central heating, double glazing, a driveway, a single garage, a beautiful rear garden, and an open rear aspect. The accommodation is focused on a bright, spacious living room. A striking fireplace creates a natural focal point for the room, and there is plenty of space for a large suite and supporting furniture.

## **The Property**





The dining kitchen can be accessed from the living room or the entrance hall, and it has been re-fitted to an exacting standard. There is a range of modern high-gloss base and wall-mounted units, arranged around a range-style cooker, giving excellent prep and storage space. There is a mixture of integrated and free-standing appliances. There is space for a dining table and French doors opening to the garden.











Climbing the stairs, the first-floor landing gives access to two double bedrooms, a bathroom, and a large loft for additional storage. Bedroom one is a generous double with integrated wardrobes and plenty of space for a full range of free-standing bedroom furniture. Bedroom two is also a spacious double. The bathroom is tiled and finished with a three-piece white suite with a shower over the bath.

Externally, the rear garden is superb. There is a large patio adjacent to the property, which creates an excellent entertaining space. There is a mature lawn, established boundary hedges, modern fencing, and the garden is fully enclosed.

Commuting is straightforward with quick access to the M8, M9, and Edinburgh City Bypass, while Edinburgh Airport is just a 10-minute drive away—ideal for regular travellers. A reliable bus service connects Ratho to Edinburgh and neighbouring towns, and nearby train stations at Edinburgh Park and South Gyle offer further transport options.
