THE LIVING ROOM







Internal accommodation is focused on the generous living room which has exposed floorboards, a lovely cornice, a beautiful fireplace, excellent levels of natural light, and plenty of space for a large suite and a table and chairs.

THE KITCHEN



The kitchen is semi-open plan to the living room and boasts a good range of base and wall-mounted units set against a tiled splashback. Space is provided for a freestanding cooker, a fridge/freezer, and a dishwasher.





The double bedroom has excellent proportions and includes a large integrated wardrobe. There is a partially tiled shower room and a separate WC which completes the accommodation.

For the fitness enthusiast, Leith Victoria Swim Centre is nearby, with a swimming pool, fitness classes, and gym, whilst neighbouring Newhaven is the home of Alien Rock, a large indoor climbing arena.





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
