aithness covers
the far north coast
of Scotland. The

Duncansby Head. The plots

Harrow Road is a hamlet on the north coast of the British Isles in Caithness, Scotland. It lies just to the west of the Castle of Mey and north-east of the Loch of Mey. Harrow Harbour is nearby and is known as Philips Harbour. It was built in the 19th Century by the Earl of Caithness for exporting the local flagstone slabs. The harbour was restored in 1978-79 by the Highland Council and is used today by a few crab and

Nearby is the Loch of Mey with an excellent walk from Harrow

Road (in line with the Castle of Mey) down to the bird hide at the loch. There is a ferry running from Gills Bay (three or four miles from Scarfskerry) across to St Margarets on the Orkney Islands.

Wick and Thurso are the main settlements based around the harbours, making their living on a mix of fishing and tourism. Inland is the desolate flat peat bogs and moorland of the Flow Country, one of the last true wilderness areas in Europe. While the population of the Flow Country is sparse, it is a popular home for numerous rare plants, insects wildlife and birds.

Wick has an airport with direct flights to Aberdeen and Edinburgh as well as a railway link to Inverness, both of these towns are with-in easy reach by road.

The area offers a great change of lifestyle and country living with all amenities within easy reach.
