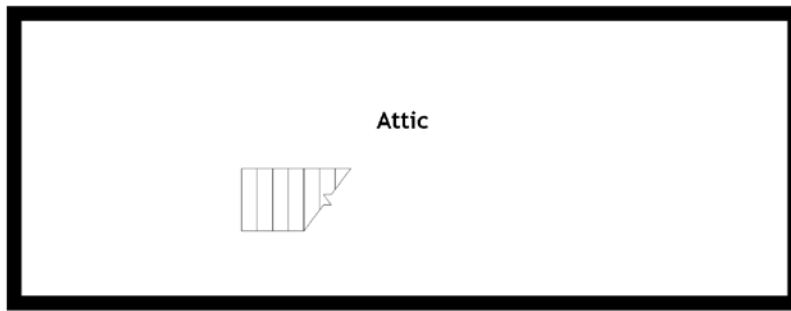
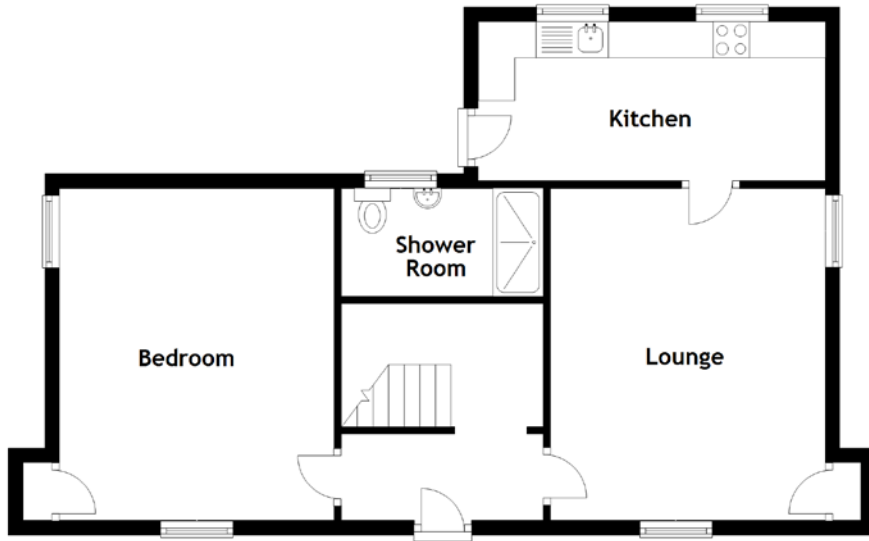

FLOOR PLAN, DIMENSIONS & MAP

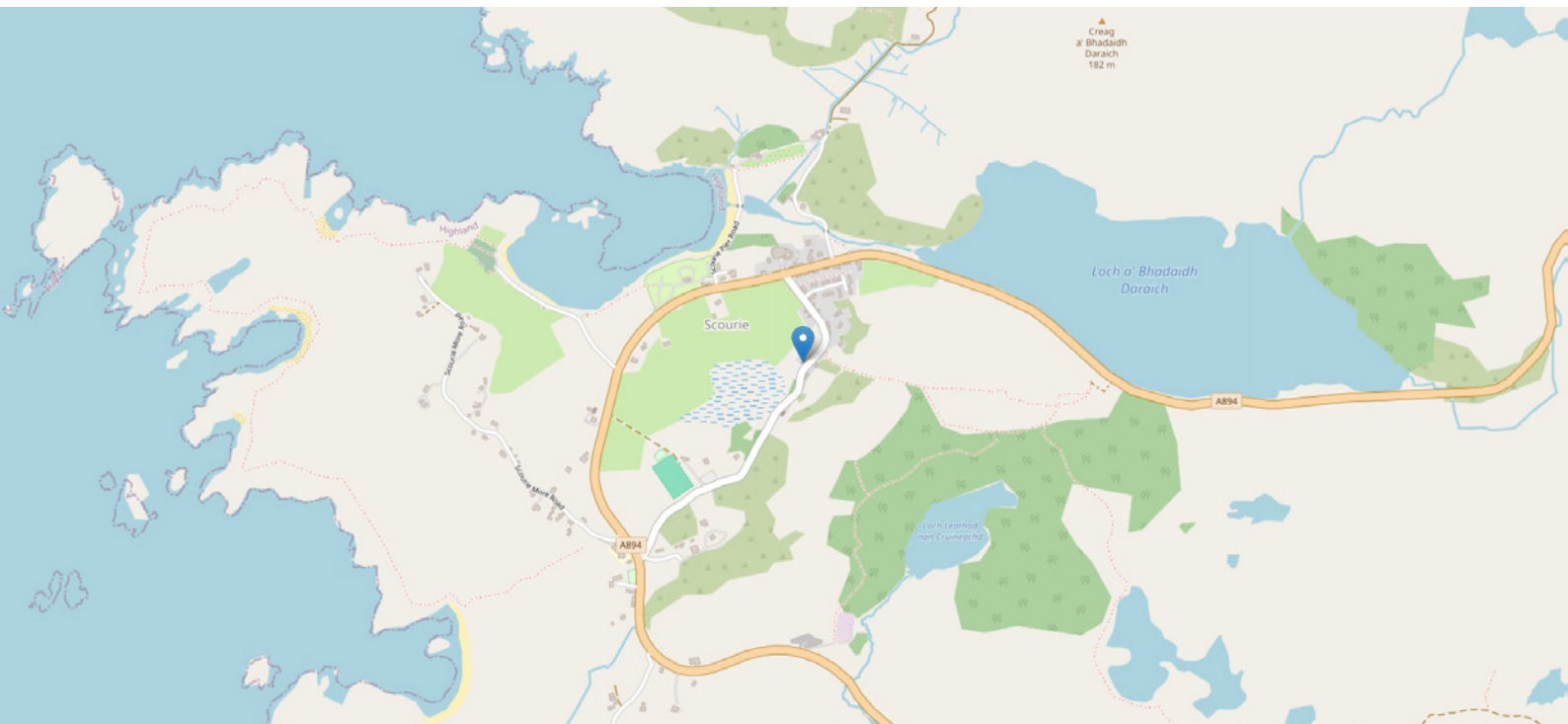

Discover tranquillity at the peaceful, sheltered Scourie beach, a haven for seabird enthusiasts. Whether observing wildlife from the bird-watching hides or marvelling at the panoramic vistas of Handa Island from the cliff point, there's no shortage of natural wonders to behold.

Scourie prides itself as perhaps the sole village worldwide where seasonal changes unveil the sight of palm trees, alongside sightings of Red and Black-throated Divers, and Highland Cattle gracing the bay's foreshore. Situated amidst the North West Highlands Geopark, Scourie's landscape bears witness to glacial sculpting, boasting a unique fusion of mountains, glens, and moorlands interspersed with myriad lochs and lochans renowned for brown trout fishing.

Scourie offers excellent local amenities to meet everyday needs, including a post office, village hall, and petrol station. Education needs are served by Scourie Primary School conveniently located within the village.
