This unique opportunity combines stunning scenery, convenient access, and endless potential, making it an ideal setting to create a truly special home.

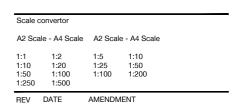


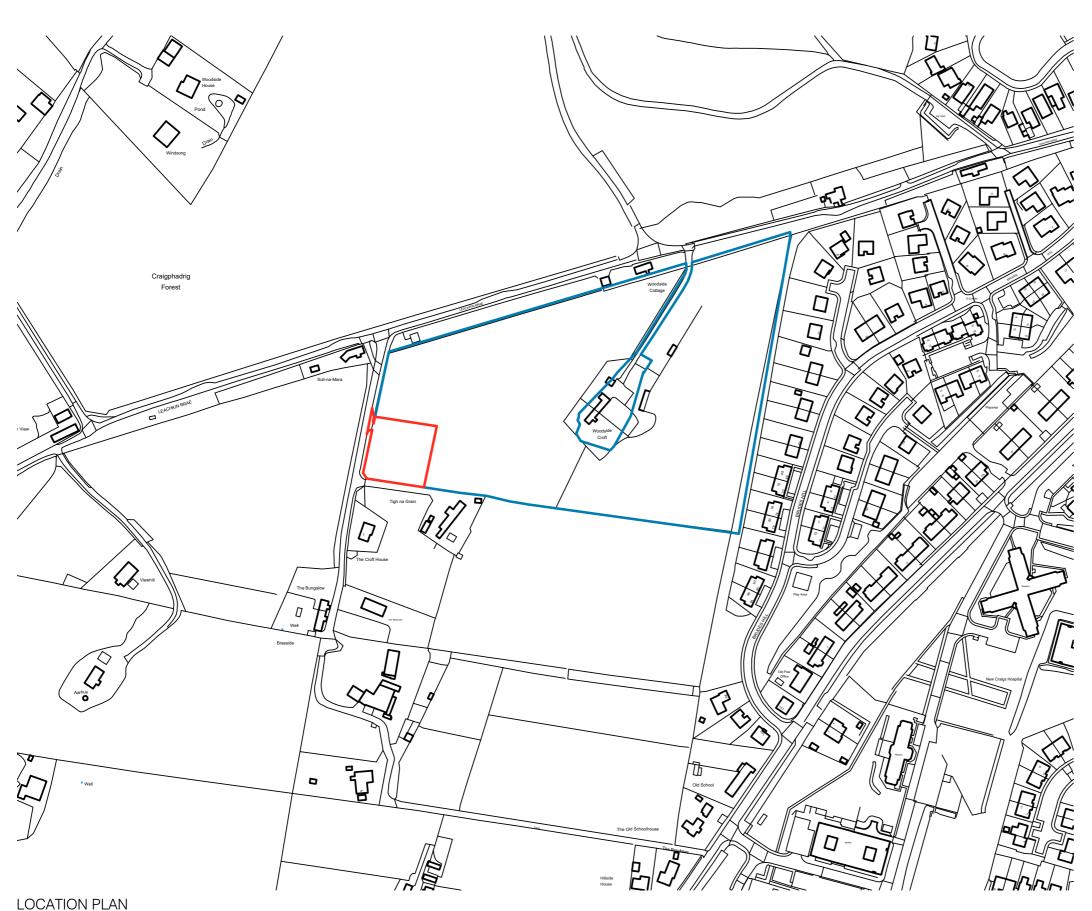
