

Charming three-bedroom home in a quiet Nairn cul-de-sac, featuring front and rear gardens, a separate dining room, and an external store





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

THE LIVING ROOM







THE DINING ROOM






THE KITCHEN








FLOOR PLAN, DIMENSIONS & MAP
